



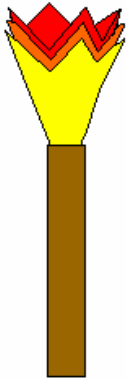
## Craft Ideas

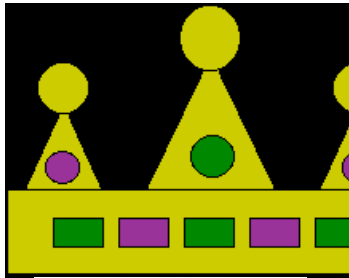


### **Paper Crowns**
