Read Genesis 15:1-18:15, 21:1-8. Put the events in the right order. Next

to each event, write the scriptural reference where the event is found. One of the visitors told Abraham that Sarah would have a son. Verses: \_\_\_\_\_ Sarai gave her handmade Hagar to Abram to produce an heir. Hagar bore Ishmael. Verses: \_\_\_\_\_ Sarah laughed within herself at the thought of having a child, and then denied doing so. Verses: \_\_\_\_\_ Sarah bore her son Isaac when Abraham was 100 years old. Sarah was old too. Verses: God changed Abram's name to Abraham and Sarai's name to Sarah. Verses: God promised Abram an heir and that he would inherit the land to which He brought him. Verses: \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_ Sarah made cakes and Abraham prepared a calf for three male visitors. Verses: \_ God promised to make Ishmael a great nation with twelve princes but that His promises to Abraham would be fulfilled through Isaac. Verses: \_\_\_\_\_\_ God promised a son to Sarah. Abraham laughed because he and Sarah were old.
