

## Israel in the Wilderness: Who Am I?

Divide the class into two teams. In turn, give each team the first clue on a card (see below). Proceed giving more clues until the team correctly identifies the answer. The team gets the number of points associated with the last clue they received before getting the answer. E.g., if the team gets the answer after the second clue, they get 8 points. Once the a team has completed their turn, play switches to the other team. Each team gets the same number of turns. The team with the most points wins.

<ol> <li>I was placed in the sky by God (10)</li> <li>God used me to lead the Israelites during the day (8)</li> <li>I was a sign to the Israelites, telling them when to stay in each place and when to go (5)</li> <li>Answer: A cloud Exodus 13:21, 40:34-38</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>I fed manna to the Israelites each morning (10)</li> <li>I provided quail to the Israelites for meat (8)</li> <li>I gave the Israelites water from a rock for drink (5)</li> <li>Answer: God Exodus 16-17</li> </ol>

<ol> <li>I was king of the Moabites (10)</li> <li>I was afraid of the Israelites (8)</li> <li>I sent important men to Balaam (5)</li> <li>I wanted Balaam to curse the Israelites (3)</li> </ol> Answer: King Balak Numbers 22:2-6	<ol> <li>I was mean and stubborn and didn't want to obey God (10)</li> <li>I was a ruler in Egypt (8)</li> <li>I died with my soldiers in the Red Sea (5)</li> <li>I refused to let the children of Israel leave Egypt (3)</li> <li>God sent many plagues on Egypt until I let the people go (1)</li> </ol> Answer: Pharaoh Exodus 7:14 - 12:33
